Road Reconstruction Project

Project Description:	Reconstruction of Morris Street from John Street to Figtree Creek
Reasons for Project:	<p>This project will upgrade narrow and/or failed sections of pavement and will also provide kerb and channel to Morris Street in locations where it currently does not exist.</p> <p>The project will also establish a stormwater surcharge flow path directly to Fig Tree Creek.</p>
Benefits of Project:	Provision of a higher level of comfort for motorists. Stormwater upgrades will result in better management of surface water during rain storms and road pavement at the end of its useful life will be replaced.
Estimated Total Cost:	\$857,000
Commencement Date:	June 2019
Duration of Project:	17 weeks

Public Consultation:	Project and Traffic Management signs will be erected and direct communication with the residents or property owners that may have periodic driveway access restrictions.
Potential Interruptions:	<p>Interruptions to normal traffic flow during various stages of the works.</p> <p>Interruptions to normal traffic flow will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Road closures with local resident access only• Reduced speeds through work areas• Short term single lane closures to manoeuvre equipment and machinery• Short term part lane closures during some excavations• Barrier fencing restricting pedestrian access to various areas

The site staff will be able to assist with alternative access arrangements on a day to day basis.
