

Kemp Beach to Wildin Way, Mulumbin

Shared Pathway – Stage 5 and 6

- Project Description:** Stage 5 & 6 is to construct a new concrete shared pathway from the existing path at Kemp Beach to Wildin Way.
- Reasons for Project:** This project is in relation to the Cycle Network Local Government Grants program which aims to link shared paths on principle links. The section identified for connection is Scenic Highway, between Statue Bay and Mulumbin Waters. Stage 5 & 6 is from Kemp Beach to Wildin Way.
- Benefits of Project:** To extend the existing shared pathway network and allow for further connections in the future.
- Estimated Total Cost:** Total cost of Stage 5 & 6 is \$1,580,000.00, with 50% funded by the Cycle Network Local Government Grants Program (CNLG) with the remaining 50% funded by the LSC.
- Commencement Date:** Works to commence mid-August, 2019
- Duration of Project:** Works to be completed in four (4) months, subject to weather and ground conditions

- Public Consultation:** Notification will be by social media and letters to affected residents. Notices will also be placed in local newspapers.
- Potential Interruptions:** Minimal disruptions to traffic and local accesses with Traffic Controllers in place when required
