





Thompson Point Road - Boat Ramp Access Road and Parking Area

Project Description: Modifications and upgrades to the existing access road

alignment and construction of a new hardstand parking area are to be conducted which forms part of a Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) project to upgrade the Thompson Point

boat ramp facility.

Reasons for Project: This project forms part of a TMR project to upgrade and

formalise the Thompson Point boat ramp facility. Currently, part of the existing road is through private land which will be realigned to the new road reserve alignment. A gravel hardstand will be placed over the existing soil to improve wet weather

access to the ramp.

Benefits of Project: The new road alignment will be placed wholly within road

reserve. Car and trailer parking will be situated on a gravel

hardstand to allow for better access in wet weather.

Estimated Total Cost: Total cost is \$150,000.00. Funding is provided by TMR.

Commencement Date: Works to commence mid-October 2019.

Duration of Project: Works to be completed in four (4) weeks, subject to weather and

ground conditions.
