

PADDYS SWAMP ROAD, BUNGUNDARRA

INTERSECTION UPGRADE

Project Description:	Upgrade of the existing intersection of Paddys Swamp Road, Ingrey Road and Madges Road at Bungundarra to a sealed intersection.
Reasons for Project:	This project will upgrade and improve the geometry of the intersection of Paddys Swamp Road, Ingrey Road, and Madges Road to meet the current and future transport needs of the community. The intersection upgrade will facilitate the extension of the Queensland B-Double network to major pineapple and fruit growing properties located in the Bungundarra region.
Benefits of Project:	Increased safety for road users
Estimated Total Cost:	A total budget of \$500,000.00 has been allocated for this Project. DTMR - HVSP is contributing \$240,000.00 and Council is contributing \$260,000.00 from the 2019-20 budget.
Commencement Date:	Works are proposed to start in early November 2019
Duration of Project:	Approximately two (2) months (subject to weather and ground conditions)

Public Consultation:	Traffic Management signs will be erected
Potential Interruptions:	Interruptions to normal traffic flows during various stages of the works. These interruptions may include; <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reduced speed through work areas• Single lane flows controlled by traffic controllers• Short term full road closures to manoeuvre machinery and trucks• Site staff will assist with alternative access arrangements on a day to day basis.
