

Barmaryee Amenities

- Project Description:** The project which is 100% funded through the Female Facilities Program (FFP) involves the architectural design and construction of a new amenities building and change rooms at the Barmaryee Multisport Precinct.
- Reasons for Project:** Female participation across these activities has continued to grow at the Precinct to the degree that there are not enough readily accessible female facilities. More specifically, on a regular basis during regular netball fixtures the male toilets have had to be opened to accommodate the demand for access to toilets for female participants.
- Benefits of Project:** This project will provide a functional and inclusive amenities building and change rooms in line with the principles of universal design to support the growing number of female participants across netball, touch football, junior rugby league, oztag, running, and school sport at the Barmaryee Multisport Precinct.
- Project Funding** Livingstone Shire Council acknowledge the Department of Housing and Public Works (Sport and Recreation) 100% funding of this project through their Female Facilities program (FFP).
- Estimated Total Cost:** \$500,000
- Commencement Date:** November 2019 (construction will commence in March 2020)
- Duration of Project:** Eight (8) months

- Potential Interruptions:** During the principle construction phase there is the possibility of some interruption to services at the Barmaryee Sports Complex, which will be managed through maintaining open communication with affiliated sporting groups and the general public.
