Discussion Items

Cr Hutton – Welcomed everyone and acknowledged Councillors and Council officers and placed apologies for the Mayor and Councillors that couldn't attend.

Cr Hutton provided brief overview of Council including:

- Provided an update on the bush fires
- The newly adopted 2030 Community Plan
- Long term financial plan and ten (10) year capital plan
- Provided overview of the five (5) themes out of the community plan

Cr Mather provided update on her portfolio including:

- Funding from the Defence force to upgrade the Stanage Bay Road, exact expenditure items still to be determined. Encouraged the community to write to council with their list of priorities.
- Seventeen (17) properties have been sold to the Australia Defence Force, which equates to 30% of the shire now owned by Defence and putting more strain on the ratepayer.
- Spoke about the boundary concerns and what it means to Livingstone Shire if it loses the Glenlee/Glendale/Rockyview/Olive Estate areas.

Cr Eastwood provided update on his portfolio including:

- Portfolio includes Arts, culture, sport, recreation, and youth. Thoroughly enjoys the portfolio as it all links to the community.
- The online world of libraries is amazing and encourages everyone to jump online and check out its services.
- Street art and Placemaking across the shire
- The Arts including upgrades to the Mill Gallery and new gallery for Emu Park.
- Youth Action Committee
