**Cr Mather** – Welcomed everyone, acknowledged the Councillors and Council officers, and placed apologies for the Mayor, Cr Hutton and Cr Kelly.

**Cr Mather** provided brief overview on key issues for this locality including:

- Seventeen (17) properties have now been sold to the Australia Defence Force, which equates to 30% of the shire now owned by Defence and putting more strain on the ratepayer.
- The matter of a possible future boundary realignment has been referred to the Electoral Commission and nothing will happen prior to the local Government elections in March 2020.

**Cr Wyatt** provided update on his portfolio including:
