

Resident asked if Council could provide additional help with grant writing.

Council advised that the community development team in Council are all experienced in grant writing and can help out when they can.

Resident enquired about the lease of the old church building. Advised that they had contacted council about putting in an Expression of Interest but have not heard anything back from Council.

Council apologised for the lack of response but provided an update on the process for the building. Council needs to assess it for building compliance including asbestos and then determine if the building would be leased as is or if repairs would be completed before being leased out.
