

Matthew Flinders Drive

Reconstruction Project - Stage 1

Project Description:	Reconstruction of Matthew Flinders Drive from Scenic Highway (north) to Edwards Street, Cooee Bay.
Reasons for Project:	This reconstruction project will include the renewal of the road pavement (as identified in the AMP), stabilise the steep embankment at the crest of the hill and upgrade stormwater pipes, pits, kerbs and channels.
Benefits of Project:	Provision of a higher level of safety for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. Stormwater upgrades will result in better management of surface water during rain storms.
Estimated Total Cost:	\$1,624,807
Commencement Date:	January 2020
Duration of Project:	Twenty eight (28) weeks

Public Consultation:	Notice of works issued to residents in the area, project and traffic management signs will be erected and direct communication with the residence or property owners that may have periodic driveway access restrictions.
Potential Interruptions:	<p>Interruptions to normal traffic flow during various stages of the works.</p> <p>Interruptions to normal traffic flow will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Road closures with local resident access only• Reduced speeds through work areas• Short term single lane closures to manoeuvre equipment and machinery• Short term part lane closures during some excavations• Barrier fencing restricting pedestrian access to various areas
