Wall Stabilisation Works

Project Description:	Engineering design and superintendency for removal of retaining wall and undertake operational works documentation and gain approvals to rectify site issues resulting in two reconfigured saleable lots
Reasons for Project:	The existing retaining wall on Gus Moore Street adjacent to 1 Ocean Circle is at risk of failing and needs to be removed or reduced in height. Earthworks will be undertaken on the allotments of 1 and 5 Ocean Circle (which are currently owned by Council) to enable the wall to be reduced in height
Benefits of Project:	The retaining wall is currently considered to be a traffic safety risk and needs to be addressed by removal / reduction in height
Estimated Total Cost:	\$430,000
Commencement Date:	Engineering Consultant – November 2019 Contractor - February 2020
Duration of Project:	Engineering Consultant 3 months Contractor – 6 weeks subject to weather and ground conditions
