

Barmaryee Road Shared Pathway

Project Description:	Construction of a new concrete shared pathway along Barmaryee Road
Reasons for Project:	This project is in relation to the Cycle Network Local Government Grants program which aims to link shared paths on principle links. The section identified for connection is Barmaryee Road, between 31 Barmaryee Road to the Barmaryee Sports Complex
Benefits of Project:	To extend the existing shared pathway network and allow for further connections in the future
Estimated Total Cost:	\$1,017,149 with 50% funded by the Cycle Network Local Government Grants Program (CNLG) and the remaining 50% funded by Council
Commencement Date:	Work commenced early November 2019
Duration of Project:	Works to be completed in six (6) months, subject to weather and ground conditions

Potential Interruptions:	Minimal disruptions to traffic and local accesses with traffic controllers in place when required
