THREATENED ECOLOGICAL COMMUNITIES

Endangered

- Brigalow (*Acacia harpophylla* dominant and codominant)
- Broad leaf tea-tree (*Melaleuca viridiflora*)
Found in woodlands in high rainfall coastal north Queensland
- Coolibah - Black Box Woodlands of the Darling Riverine Plains and the Brigalow Belt South Bioregions
- Natural Grasslands of the Queensland Central Highlands and northern Fitzroy Basin
- Poplar Box Grassy Woodland on Alluvial Plains
- Semi-evergreen vine thickets of the Brigalow Belt (North and South) and Nandewar Bioregions
- Weeping Myall Woodlands

Critically Endangered

- Littoral Rainforest and Coastal Vine Thickets of Eastern Australia
